**1 Subodh Gupta, "A Glass of Water"** **FREE**  
Hauser & Wirth  
A giant button, teakettle and tape measure by this Indian artist put a subcontinental spin on living large. ▶ **Through June 18; see Uptown**



**2 Hilary Harnischfeger** **FREE**  
Rachel Uffner  
Paper, plaster, paint, quartz chunks and ceramic pieces are all part of this artist's recipe for lovably lumpy abstract reliefs. ▶ **Through June 19; see Lower East Side**



**3 Roe Ethridge, "Le Luxe"** **FREE**  
Andrew Kreps Gallery  
The genre-jumping photographer returns with new works, including a series commissioned by Goldman Sachs that took six years to complete. Other pieces dwell tangentially on the subject of luxury. ▶ **Through July 2; see Chelsea**



**4 "Francis Alÿs: A Story of Deception"**  
The Belgian-born, Mexico City-based artist takes up space in both MoMA branches with his unique brand of art. Alÿs's speciality is pushing boundaries: between dream and reality, faith and reason, and the developed and developing worlds. ▶ **MoMA PS 1; through Sept 12 + Museum of Modern Art; Aug 1. The artist has gone from the dense, Rorschach-like paintings of his previous show to portraits, but the street-art feel remains. ▶ **Through June 11; see Soho**

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
